Dear Mr. O'Reilly,

I am to refer to your Circular issued on 01/07/11 re Cost Containment measures to be effected from, 04-07-11.

I am concerned to reflect the concerns of our members regarding:

- \rightarrow The lack of consultation and arbitrary nature of the decision making in this matter
- → The breach of the established Terms and Conditions of Employment of Employees of the National Ambulance Service.
- → The unilateral removal of the rights of staff in Dublin North Leinster which states that "any ambulance personnel who are required to work on their rostered days off will receive double time for all the hours worked".
- \rightarrow The discriminatory nature of the decision to exclude control staff and ambulance officers from this edict.
- \rightarrow The particular emphasis on dropping of ambulance from an already under resourced service.

In conclusion I am to advise that we will do whatever is required to protect our members. As ever NASRA remain available for discussion.
